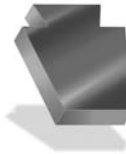
- *Five Visioning Sessions were held to engage community leaders in WVCA's future planning*

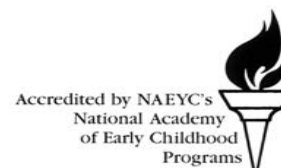

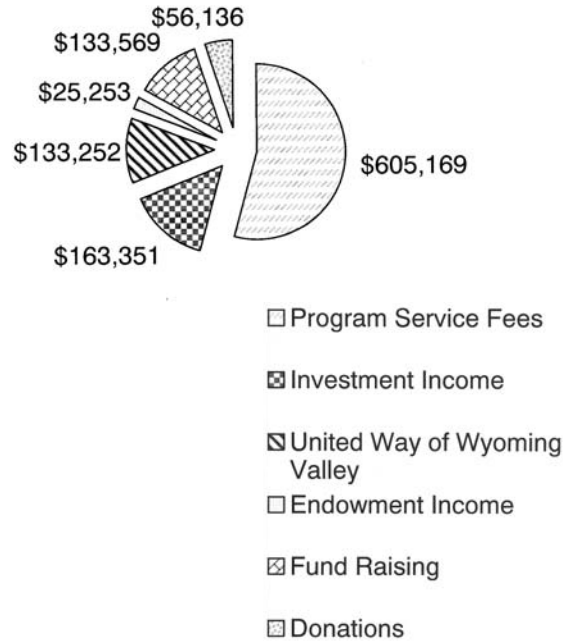

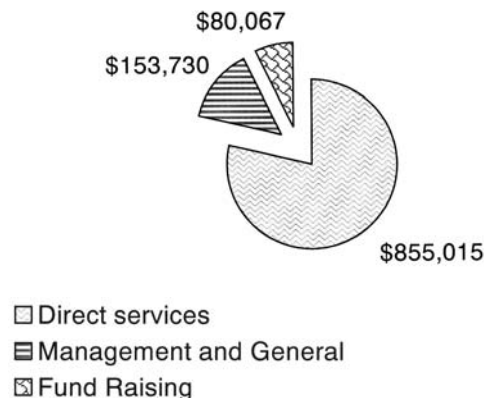

Wyoming Valley Children's Association (WVCA) is a nonprofit agency that has served local children and their families since 1924. Formed by members of the Wilkes-Barre Rotary Club as Wyoming Valley Crippled Children's Association, the agency has grown in the past 80 years from a small orthopedic clinic to a full service agency serving the various therapeutic needs of youngsters who have all types of developmental and neurological disabilities.

WVCA's primary mission is to support children, ages 0 - 5 years, who have developmental delays and disabilities by providing physical, occupational and speech therapy and early childhood education. The agency employs a team approach in service delivery. A cooperative emphasis with families, therapists, teachers and service coordinators ensures that the services provided are appropriate, comprehensive and family-focused.
